- 1.) Approval of Minutes from January 6, 2022: Motion to approve the minutes was made by Nicolaus, and seconded by Hildebrand.
- 2.) **Discussion on Comprehensive Plan:** Bay Lakes Regional Planning Commission. No handout material submitted: Brandon Robinson from Bay Lakes Regional Planning was present to speak to the Commission about portions of the Comprehensive plan that is being drafted for the City of Plymouth. Some of the areas he covered were of the future land use maps, how the land within the City is currently used, things to consider, and that are being considered when planning out the City's growth. Robinson is considering an April 7, 2022 return to the Commission to review the progress, and then considering a May "open house" for the Public to attend prior to the May Plan Commission Meeting.
