## Meeting Minutes

Call to Order – Roll Call: Randy Schmitz called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Members present were Mark Levandowski, Steve Stavola, Jo Clark, Katie Schroeder, Greg Hildebrand and were absent. - 4. Discussion and possible action regarding future Ski Hill operations: Van Derven represented a civilian group interested in exploring interest in and improvements for the Nutt Ski Area. He informed the committee that a survey had been sent home with area school children to gauge interest in a renovated ski/tubing hill.
