Sealed bids, for the City of Plymouth "Riverfront Parking Improvements" Contract, will be received by the City Clerk, City Hall, 128 Smith St. - P.O. Box 107, Plymouth, WI 53073, until December 12, 2025, at 10:00 am, local time. Bids are required to be submitted electronically through www.QuestCDN.com. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the above time at the office of the City Clerk.

The work includes furnishing of all materials and equipment and performance of the following work, per the Plans, Specifications and Contract Documents (PS & CD).

The project is located on an existing parking area just north of the Mullet River and southwest of the intersection of Stafford St and Mill Street. A brief description of the major work items for the above contract includes:

2,000 cubic yards of excavation common, 4,450 tons of base aggregate dense, 515 linear feet of storm sewer, 9 storm sewer structures, 1,350 linear feet of curb and gutter, 1,800 tons of HMA pavement.
