## Schedule F-1: Public Fire-Protection Service

The City of Plymouth has chosen to have its water utility bill the retail general service customers for public fire-protection service under Section 196.03(3)(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes. This rate is in addition to Schedules Mg-1, Ug-1, Mgt-1 and Mz-1.

Available to all water customers residing inside the corporate limits of the City of Plymouth and, as approved by the Plymouth Common Council, to water customers residing outside the city.

## Schedule Ug-1: General Water Service - Unmetered

Available to single-family and small commercial customers who temporarily are taking water service on an unmetered basis where the utility cannot immediately install its water meter. This rate approximates the cost of 600 cubic feet per month under Schedule Mg-1. If it is determined by the utility that the usage is more than 600 cubic feet per billing period, an additional charge per Schedule Mg-1 will be made for the estimated additional usage.

Monthly Service Charge:
Each water connection.......................................................... \$27.30

## Schedule Mgt-1: Seasonal, Emergency or Temporary Service

Available to water customers who take service under seasonal, emergency or temporary basis. Each customer under this schedule shall pay an annual seasonal minimum bill (which will not be pro-rata for less than a year).

## Annual Service Charge:

12 times the applicable monthly service charge under Schedule Mg-1

## Plus Volume Charge:

Determined by the applicable monthly volume charge under Schedule Mg-1 and added to the annual bill.

## Schedule Mz-1: Building and Construction Water Service

Available to water customers for building and construction of single-family and small commercial buildings. Not available to water customers for building and construction of large commercial, industrial, or multiple apartment buildings (for such requires that a temporary meter be installed and handled under Schedule Mg-1).

Monthly Service Charge:
Apply the unmetered rate under Schedule Ug-1

## Schedule Upf-1: Private Fire-Protection Service - Unmetered

Available to water customers with unmetered connections to the main for automatic fire sprinkler systems, standpipes and private hydrants. This rate is in addition to Schedules Mg-1, Ug-1, Mgt-1 and Mz-1.

## Schedule BW-1: Bulk Water

Available to water customers from the water system through hydrants or other connections which shall be metered, or at the direction of the utility, estimated. Utility personnel or utilityapproved party shall supervise the delivery of the water for:

1. Water supplied to tank truck or from hydrant for the purpose of extinguishing fires outside the utility's immediate service area;
2. Water supplied by tank truck or from hydrant for purposes other than extinguishing fires such as irrigation or the filling of swimming pools; or,
3. Water supplied from hydrants or other temporary connections for general service type of applications. (Water supplied for construction purposes - see Schedule Mz-1.)

Deposit:
The utility may require a deposit for use of its equipment. Refund of the deposit will be made upon return of the utility's equipment. Damaged or loss equipment will be repaired or replaced at customer's expense.

## Schedule Mpa-1: Public Service

Available to water customers who are governmental agencies and use water on an intermittent basis for flushing sewers, street sprinkling, flooding skating rinks, drinking fountains, etc., where it is impossible to measure the service. The water utility shall estimate the volume of water used based on the pressure, size of opening and period of time that water is allowed to be drawn.

Volume Charge: $\quad \$ 3.32$ per estimated 100 cubic feet
$\$ 4.44$ per 1,000 gallons

## Schedule Am-1: Additional Meter Rental Charge

Available to customers as a sewage deduct meter to receive credit for water not discharged into the sanitary sewer, or as a sewage meter for those who are not customers of the water utility. The minimum rental period shall be one year.

## Schedule Cz-1: Water Service Installation Charge

As requested, the water utility will install the initial water service line from the main through the curb stop and box.

## COMBINED METERING

Volumetric meter readings will be combined for billing if the utility for its own convenience places more than one meter on a single water service. Multiple meters placed for the purpose of identifying water not discharged into the sanitary sewer are not considered for utility convenience and shall not be combined for billing. Meter readings from individually metered separate services shall not be combined for billing purposes.

Buildings used in the same business, located on the same parcel and served by a single service may have the customer's water supply piping installed to a central point so that the volume can be metered in one place.

## RIGHT OF ACCESS TO METERS

The utility has the right to access to the customer's premises at all reasonable times for the purpose of installing, reading, inspecting, repairing or removing any meter, device or other equipment used in connection with providing electric, water or sewage service.

## TERMS OF PAYMENT

The bill for electric, water or sewage service constitutes the sum of any fixed charge, plus billing for amount used or minimum billing. Payments are due on the date specified on the bill. The customer may be given a written disconnect notice for a past due bill 20 days after the bill is issued and unless payment or satisfactory arrangement for payment is made within the next 8 days, service may be disconnected pursuant to Chapter PSC 113 and 185 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.

If service is disconnected for non-payment of bill, a reconnection charge will be added to the service billing. When deferred payment arrangements are requested, such must be in written form. Verbal arrangements are not acceptable.

Late Payment Charge: A charge of one percent per month will be added to bills not paid within 20 days from date of issuance.

If payment is made by check and the check is returned by the financial institution marked: "NO ACCOUNT, ACCOUNT CLOSED, or INSUFFICIENT FUNDS", an additional charge of $\$ 25.00$ will be added to the service billing.
