**Ordinance No. 15 of 2019**

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING SECTION 10-4-3  
OF THE OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF  
THE CITY OF PLYMOUTH, WISCONSIN**

**WHEREAS**, the Sartori Company ("Sartori") previously utilized the railroad crossing to go between its East Main Street and West Main Street facilities, and due to the railroad crossing closure, Sartori's employees cannot easily navigate between its two facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, Sartori requests the use of an all-terrain vehicle and utility terrain vehicle ("ATV/UTV") route between its two facilities for employees to travel efficiently between the facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to a request from Sartori, the Public Works & Utilities Committee recommends an ordinance for the purpose of establishing an ATV/UTV route in the City of Plymouth for the benefit of Sartori; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 23.33, a municipality may designate certain roadways as all-terrain vehicle routes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Common Council of the City of Plymouth deems it appropriate to designate certain highways as all-terrain vehicle routes.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Common Council of the City of Plymouth does hereby ordain as follows:

**Section 1. Creating All-Terrain Vehicle Route and Regulation.** Section 10-4-3 of the Municipal Code of the City of Plymouth is hereby created to read as follows:

**"SEC. 10-4-3 ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE ROUTE AND REGULATION.**

(a) **Route.** The following is designated as an ATV/UTV route pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 23.33(8):

Beginning at the railroad closure on North Milwaukee Street and going North to Elizabeth Street; thence West on Elizabeth Street to Western Avenue; thence southeasterly on Western Avenue to the corner of West Main Street to the entrance of Sartori's West Main Street facility."


**Section 2. Severability.** Should any portion of this Ordinance or the affected Municipal Code Section be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall not be affected.

**Section 3. Distribution of Ordinance.** The City Clerk shall provide a copy of this ordinance to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, the state traffic patrol, and the Sheboygan County Sheriff's Department.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall take effect the day after publication.
